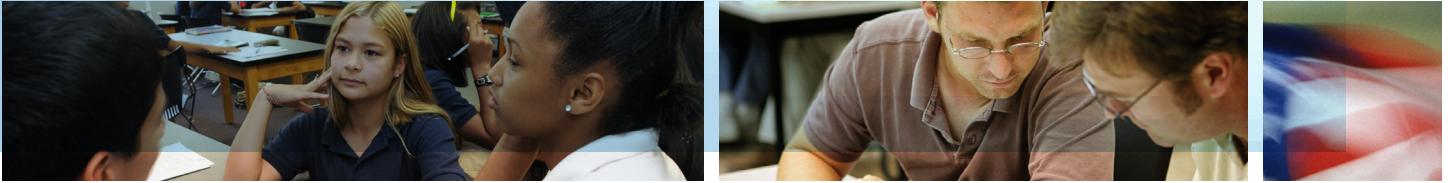
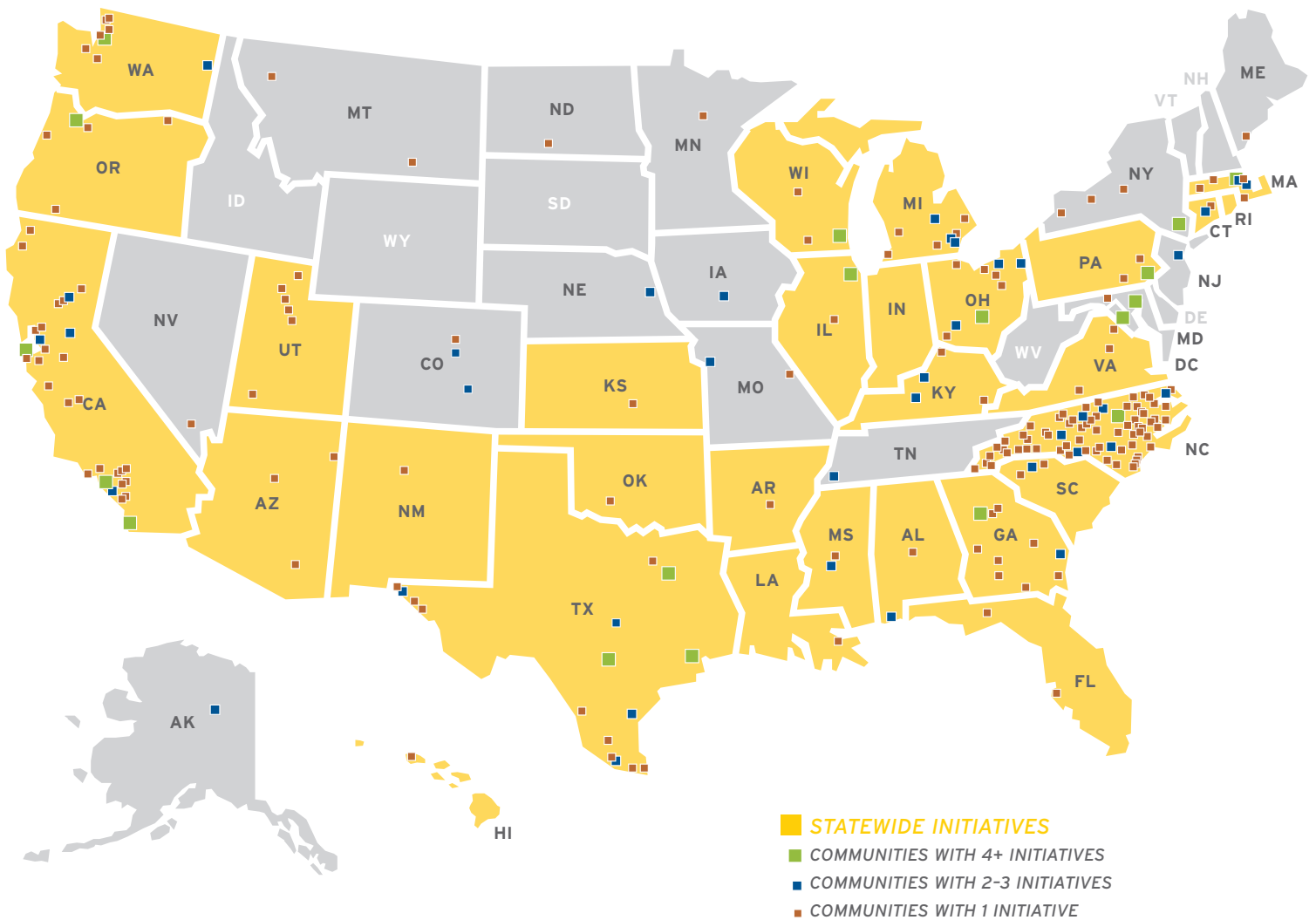

MAJOR INITIATIVES



ACCELERATING OPPORTUNITY: Seeking to fundamentally change the way Adult Basic Education is delivered in 11 states, and ensuring that those states' policies encourage dramatically improved student outcomes in terms of completing credentials of value in the labor market.



ACHIEVING THE DREAM: Helping community college students earn valued credentials and using data to track and ensure student success at more than 130 colleges in 24 states.



BACK ON TRACK: Developing school designs that reengage off-track and out-of-school youth, enabling them to earn postsecondary credentials.



BREAKING THROUGH: Enabling adults with little education to prepare for and succeed in technical programs at 41 community colleges in 22 states.



CONNECTING LITERACY AND WORK: Advancing low-skilled adults in their careers by linking adult literacy programs to workforce initiatives in 5 communities.



COUNSELING TO CAREERS: Transforming college and career counseling by creating and better connecting youth and adults to "best bet" career pathways.



DEVELOPMENTAL EDUCATION INITIATIVE: Promoting a state policy and capacity-building agenda to support 6 states' efforts to improve college completion for students who test into developmental education.



EARLY COLLEGE DESIGN SERVICES: Helping school districts prepare all students for college, based on the successes of our 230 early college high schools across 28 states.
